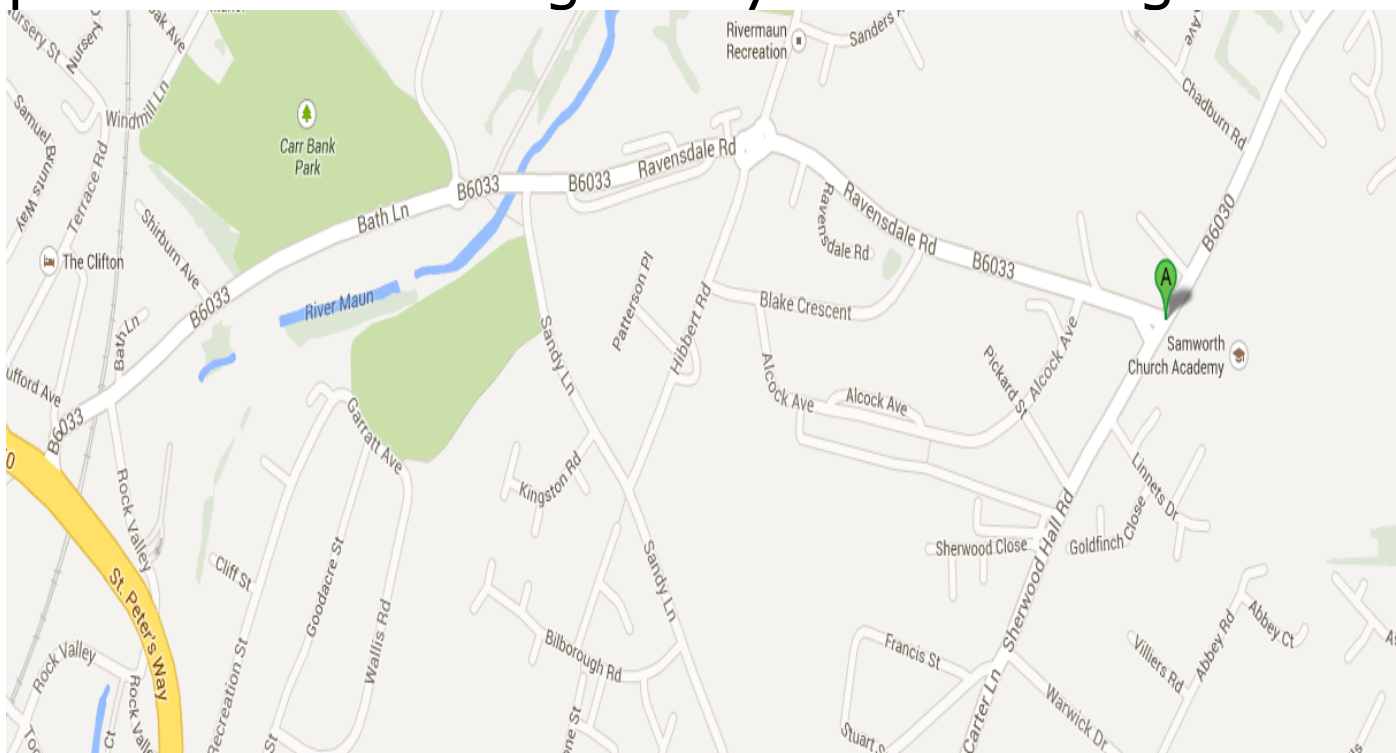

**Venue:** The Samworth Church Academy, Sherwood Hall Road, Mansfield, NG18 2DY (see location details below).

**Closing Date for Entries: Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2014.** Late entries only by prior arrangement and at organiser's discretion. **No entries accepted on the day.**

**Number Limits:** Due to limitations of space and for comfort for those attending the event limits may be imposed on each category. **If required some entries may be refused.**

**Conditions of Entry:** BFA membership, LPJS membership, all other equipment conforming to current BFA regulations:

Fencing shoes or appropriate trainers	Long Socks (must go over the knees and be covered by the breeches)
Breeches (350 Newtons)	T- shirt
Under Plastron - 800N under plastron for U15 & U17 / 350N under plastron for U9, U11 & U13	Chest protector (mandatory for girls, and many boys also wear them)
Fencing jacket (350 Newtons)	Lamé – the conductive vest worn over the jacket
Body wire (at least 2 fully working)	Mask - U9, U11 & U13 foil entrants do not require 'on target' bib / U15 & U17 foil entrants require an 'on target' bib and mask wire
Mask Wire – U15 & U17 only	Glove
<b>Electric weapons appropriate for age category (at least 2 fully working)</b>	
<b>U9 all weapons will be fought using size 0 blades</b>	<b>U11 and U13 foil will be fought using Size 3 blades</b>
<b>U15 &amp; U17 will be fought on size 5 weapons</b>	

**Catering:** There will be a stand selling full refreshments and drinks during the competition (all proceeds from the catering stall will be donated to charity) including hand made sandwiches, cakes, fruit, crisps, soft drinks, hot & cold drinks.

**Competition Rules.** The format of the competition will be two rounds of pools followed by Direct Elimination to a final four. Where multiple pools exists the results from the first round of pools will be used to seed the second round. The competition will be run in accordance with BFA & LPJS rules at the organisers' discretion.

**Please note there will be no equipment for loan at the competition. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure the serviceability of their equipment and that they have the correct size weapons and in-regulation clothing. Referees will be checking kit and weapons at the start of each pool and DE fight.**

**COMPETITORS PRESENTING ON THE PISTE WITHOUT THE CORRECT EQUIPMENT WILL BE SCRATCHED FROM THE EVENT.**

*Medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> (Gold), 2<sup>nd</sup> (Silver) & 3<sup>rd</sup> (Bronze) equal places in all age & gender categories*

*All entrants will receive a certificate of participation in the competition*

*Highest pool result after 2 rounds in each age & gender category will also receive a trophy*

**Age Group breakdowns:** Fencer's age at 01/01/2014 is the age for this competition, ie if a fencer is 16 on 01/01/2014 then fencer should be entered into U17 category, even if they become 17 during 2014 but before the competition. Likewise if fencer is 9 at 01/01/2014 then fencer should be entered into under 9 category, even if they become 10 during 2014 but before the competition.

**Age Bands:**

U9 - After the 01.01.2005

U11 - 01.01.2003 to 31.12.2004

U13 - 01.01.2001 to 31.12.2002

U15 - 01.01.1999 to 31.12.2000

U17 - 01.01.1997 to 31.12.1998

**Refereeing:** Referees are welcome (and encouraged) from clubs entering fencers into the competition. It is good form for any clubs entering 3 or more fencers to the competition to bring at least 1 referee to assist the competition.
